

The adhesive REDI ADHESIVO PVC fulfills the requirements of the emission limits for Volatile Organic Content (VOC) established by “State of California South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule 1168/316A” Amended January 7, 2005. The VOC concentration in its formula is less than the accepted limit of 510 g/L except water corresponding to the special application “PVC welding”.

According to LEED's (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design), adhesives used in the interior of buildings must comply with the South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule 1168.

LEED is one of the most popular green building certification programs used worldwide. It was developed by the non-profit U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) and includes a set of rating systems for the design, construction, operation, and maintenance of green buildings, homes, and neighborhoods that aims to help building owners and operators be environmentally responsible and use resources efficiently.
